This course is a combination of units taught in the trimester study period where you self-enrol, and credential units, which are a manual enrolment process.

Credentials have twelve entry points per year and you will have six months to complete a credential from the time of enrolment.

The credentials may be attempted separately or simultaneously and are assessed by an assessment panel that includes both academic and industry representatives.

You are free to do your credentials when and in the order you wish, but we do recommend undertaking credentials 1-4 first, so that if you decide not to complete the Masters, you can exit with a Graduate Certificate. Credentials usually take 2-4 weeks to prepare and submit and up to 5 weeks for video testimony, assessment and result.

You can withdraw from credential units before the census date.
