



Enrolling in single Law units to comply with requirements of the Victorian Legal Admissions Board for admission to legal practice

If you wish to be admitted to legal practice in Victoria, but studied Law in another jurisdiction, you will need to apply to the Victorian Legal Admissions Board (VLAB) for an assessment of your qualifications. If VLAB determines that you still need to meet academic areas of knowledge in order to qualify for admission to practice in Victoria, VLAB will give you a letter specifying those areas of knowledge.

Deakin University offers units of study that VLAB has confirmed meet the academic areas of knowledge to qualify for admission to practice in Victoria. Law graduates can enrol in those units as single units (non-award). If you wish to enrol in single units at Deakin, please forward the letter you received from VLAB together with your enrolment application.

Choosing your units

- The table below indicates the units of study at Deakin that meet the academic areas of knowledge. In some instances, you will need to complete more than one unit of study to meet a single academic area of knowledge.
- You can choose to enrol in either undergraduate or postgraduate Law units to meet an academic area of knowledge. Postgraduate Law units tend to be distinguished from the undergraduate units by their focus on policy issues.
- If you need to meet several academic areas of knowledge, you can enrol in undergraduate units to meet one area of knowledge and in postgraduate units to meet another area of knowledge.
- However, if you need to complete multiple units of study to meet a single academic area of knowledge, you must select units at the same level (either undergraduate or postgraduate) for the purpose of meeting that area of knowledge.
