 - Option A (ACX703, ACX707, ACX708, ACC700*) Or
 - Option B# (ACX703, ACX704, ACX705, ACX706); and

I must complete 4 credit points of elective units from any of the specialisations in the course (up to 2 credits may be chosen from any equivalent post graduate course)

I must complete AAI018 Academic Integrity (0-credit-point compulsory unit)

*OR an elective related to the research project where no appropriate internship is available #(only by approval of Course Director, based on performance in ACX703, and agreement of supervisor)
