M325 course rules - In order to qualify for the award of Bachelor of Business (M325), students must complete 24 credit points, which must include the following:

12 credit points of core units;

One 6 credit point Bachelor of Business major;

6 credit points of elective units;

At least 6 credit points at level 3 (4 credit points must be course grouped to a Faculty of Business and Law undergraduate degree);

No more than 10 credit points at level 1; and

Completion of MAI010 Academic Integrity (0-credit-point compulsory unit).

The 12 credit points of core units must include:-

- 7 credit points of foundation units;
- 3 credit points of Personal Edge (transferrable skills) units;
- a one credit point capstone unit MMM315; and
- a one credit point Work Integrated Learning (WIL) unitor an approved international study experience.
