M325 course rules - In order to qualify for the award of Bachelor of Business (M325), students must complete 24 credit points, which must include the following:

12 credit points of core units;

One 6 credit point Bachelor of Business major;

6 credit points of elective units;

At least 6 credit points at level 3 (4 credit points must be course grouped to a Faculty of Business and Law undergraduate degree);

No more than 10 credit points at level 1; and

Completion of MAI010 Academic Integrity (0-credit-point compulsory unit).

The 12 credit points of core units must include:-

7 credit points of foundation units;

3 credit points of Career Skills (transferrable skills) units;

a one credit point capstone unit - MMM315; and

a one credit point Work Integrated Learning (WIL) unit or an approved international study experience.

GENERAL INFORMATION

This course map is a guide only. You must, in addition to using this map, ensure you meet the course rules and structure as set out in the official University Handbook - of the year you commenced your course (deakin.edu.au/handbook). This course map has been created to be used electronically.

A typical enrolment pattern for full time study is three to four units (or credit points) each study period. A typical enrolment pattern for part time study is one to two units (or credit points) each study period, which in turn will extend the duration of your studies. The need or option to study in Trimester 3 is dependent on your course rules and structure.
