1 credit point of Early Years Teaching Specialisation in one of either i) Promoting Equity, Social Justice and Inclusivity; ii) Arts Education; or iii) Aboriginal Knowledge and Experiences (see options above); and

Satisfactory completion of 115 days of supervised professional experience

GENERAL INFORMATION
