Note: Some units have a co-requisite unit, which means the co-requisite unit must have already been completed or will be completed in the same study period as the credit point unit. A co-requisite unit only needs to be completed once in your degree. For example: HSN106 Food Fundamentals has a co-requisite unit of HSN010 Food and Nutrition Laboratory Safety. HSE208 Integrated Human Physiology has a co-requisite of HSE010 Exercise and Sport Science Laboratory Safety. SLE133 Chemistry in our World has a co-requisite of SLE010 Laboratory and Fieldwork Safety Induction Program.

Students who are planning on applying for Master of Dietetics course in future: Completing units at other institutions, instead of the approved H718 dietetic pre-requisites units at Deakin is strongly discouraged (even if previously approved as equivalent) as we cannot guarantee that they will be eligible for dietetics, even if Credit for Prior Learning is granted.

- Must pass 6 credit points at level {3}
- Must pass no more than 10 credit points at level {1}
- Must pass 4 credit points in unit set {H318 Elective Units}
- Must pass 2 elective unit(s) which can be selected from any faculty

As there are only 2 elective spaces in this course, other major options are not available, however you may choose to undertake the units within other majors, as electives.
