In order to qualify for the award of Master of Teaching (Secondary)(E763), students must complete 16 credit points, which must include the following:

- 7 core units (8 credit points);
- 2 curriculum study units in a first teaching method area;
- 2 curriculum study units in a second teaching method area;
- 4 credit points in one of the following specialisations: Inclusive Education, Research, Languages Teaching or Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages (TESOL); Trauma Response
- DAIOO1 Academic Integrity and Respect at Deakin (O-credit-point compulsory unit);
- ELNO10 Australian Literacy Test (O-credit-point compulsory unit);
- ELNO11 Australian Numeracy Test (O-credit-point compulsory unit); and
- Completion of 60 days of supervised professional experience and successful completion of the Deakin Teaching Performance Assessment.
