D338 Course Rules -

I understand that to qualify for the award Bachelor of International Studies/Bachelor of Commerce (D338) I must complete 32 credit points. 16 credit points in each of the Faculty of Arts and Education and the Faculty of Business and Law.

Course requirements for both degrees must be satisfied.

Also:

I must complete 16 credit points from the Bachelor of International Studies included:

- 6 credit points of core units
- an approved Arts 8-credit-point major sequence from the campus at which I am enrolled
- an approved international experience (2 credit points minimum), preferably in the fourth year of my course

I must complete 16 credit points from the Bachelor of Commerce included:

- 8 credit points of core units - MAA103, MAE101, MAF101, MIS171, MLC101, MMK101, MMM132, MWL101 and MCA010 (0 credit points)
- one prescribed Commerce major sequence of 8 credit points
- A minimum of 4 credit points at level 3 of Commerce coded units

I must complete no more than 12 credit points of units at level 1

I understand that if I decide to complete my studies with only one of these two degrees, I will come and speak to a Course Adviser for assistance

Please note that the credit points attached to each international experience are fixed – please see a Course Adviser for details.

Study at an overseas university exchange partner or an approved study abroad program

Interested students should start planning in April of their first year of study (or equivalent) and begin the process by meeting with the Exchange Officer in Arts Student Services or the Education Abroad Office. Exchange and study abroad programs are normally undertaken in second year (or equivalent).

International internship AIS330 (two credit points) or AIS331 (four credit points) or approved onshore internship with an international organisation (AIS330 only)

Interested students should start planning in May of their second year of study (or equivalent) and begin the process by meeting with a course adviser in Student Services. Internships are normally undertaken in third year (or equivalent).
