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E200 course rules - In order to qualify for the award of Associate Degree of Education (E200), students must complete 16 credit points, which must include the following:

4 credit points of foundation units;

12 credit points of core units; and

Casper Test prior to Year 3 commencing

E359 course rules - In order to qualify for the award of Bachelor of Education (Primary) (E359), students must complete 32 credit points, which must include the following:

26 core units;

4 credit points of primary specialisation units;

2 credit points of elective units;

satisfactory completion of 80 days supervised professional experience

no more than 10 credit points at level 1

2 compulsory units ELN010 Literacy Test (0 credit point) and ELN011 Numeracy Test (0 credit point)

AAI018 Academic Integrity (0-credit-point compulsory unit)

Mathematics and Numeracy (SIT176, ESM215, ESM303 and ECP400)
