E771 course rules - In order to qualify for the award of Master of Education (E771), students must complete 12 credit points, which must include the following:

Completion of AAI018 Academic Integrity (0-credit-point compulsory unit); and

Option 1: Dual Specialist Strand

2 credit points of core units;

4 research units (EDX701, EDX712, EDX703 and EDX704);

4 units of course electives from a single specialist strand;

2 units of course electives from another specialist strand;

OR

Option 2: Research Intensive Strand

2 credit points of core units;

6 research units (EDX701, EDX712, EDX705 (2 credit points) and EDX706 (2 credit points));

4 units of course electives from a single specialist strand.
