E200 COURSE RULES

- Must pass 16 credit points for course
- 4 credit points of foundation units;
- 9 credit points of core units;
- No more than 14 credit points of units at Level 1
- AAI018 Academic Integrity (0-credit-point compulsory unit) Casper Test prior to Year 3 commencing

E359 COURSE RULES

- Must pass 32 credit points for course
- 26 core units
- 4 credit points of primary subject specialisation (this includes one of the 'core' units ECP400 as it sits in each specialisation option)
- 2 credit points of elective units
- Satisfactory completion of 80 days supervised professional experience, and students must successfully complete the Deakin Teaching Performance Assessment
- A minimum of 10 credit points of units at level 3 or above
- No more than 10 credit points of units at level 1
- Compulsory units ELN010 Literacy Test (0 credit point) and ELN011 Numeracy Test (0 credit point) required in order to graduate from the course
- AAI018 Academic Integrity (0-credit-point compulsory unit) (if not already completed in E200)

GENERAL INFORMATION

IB PYP Teaching and Learning Certificate

If you would like to be eligible to apply for the IB PYP Teaching and Learning Certificate from the IBO, in addition to your core coursework you will need to successfully complete two elective units EEG402 and ECL307 and two x Yr 3 Professional Experience placements in IB PYP schools.

Inclusive Education Sequence

If you would like to complete the Inclusive Education sequence, you will need to successfully complete two elective units EEI202 and ECE404 and will be supported to focus on inclusive education practices during your Year 3 Professional Experience placements.

SPECIFIC COURSE INFORMATION

If students are seeking to undertake the Inclusive Education or IBPYP elective streams you will need to move the elective unit currently located in Year 4 Trimester 2. To ensure a full load in Year 4 Trimester 2 you can move forward ESM410, which is an online unit and will therefore be more manageable around placements than any other level 4 unit.
