Checklist

Please ensure the following documentation are uploaded to your application in the applicant portal:

- Personal statement (1 page maximum, single spaced, 11-point font). This should briefly address each of the following:
 - a positioning statement regarding your interest in the clinical psychology area of practice endorsement;
 - identification of relevant work experience, briefly explaining how these experiences have inspired your interest in clinical psychology training;
 - relevance of the Deakin Master of Clinical Psychology (Post-Registration) to your specific aspirations and circumstances.
- Proof of general registration as a psychologist with the **Psychology Board of Australia** and that you have practiced for a minimum of 12 months full-time equivalent, without conditions upon this registration. Applicants will be requested to share their registration number which will be reviewed to assess their current registration status.
- Curriculum Vitae, including specifications of relevant Continuing Professional Development
- Proof of name change, if relevant (e.g., marriage certificate)
- Certified transcripts of all your tertiary education studies. These should indicate the name of the
 qualification, the institution of enrolment, the years of study, the subjects / units undertaken, the
 grades achieved, explanatory notes concerning the grades, and proof that the qualification has
 been completed (certification not required for Deakin University transcripts)
- If you have studied in a country other than Australia or another English speaking country, check if you meet <u>Deakin's English language requirements.</u>





Professional Referee Reports

Reports from two referees are required to assist the University in assessing the standard of your previous academic achievements and your suitability for further study in clinical psychology. We recommend one professional and one academic reference. To process your referee reports you will need to access the Psychology Reference Portal. This referee system is used across universities. To be able to use the system, you will need to have an active subscription.
