D323 Course Rules

I understand that to qualify for the award of Bachelor of International Studies/Bachelor of Laws (D323) I must complete 40 credit points consisting of 24 credit points from the Faculty of Business and Law and 16 credit points from the Faculty of Arts. Course requirements for both degrees must be satisfied.

Also:

I must complete 24 credit points from the Bachelor of Laws include: - 16 core LLB units

- 8 credit points of LLB electives

I must complete the 16 credit points from the Bachelor of International Studies include:

- 6 credit points of core units

- an approved Arts major sequence of at least 8 credit points from the campus at which I am enrolled

- an approved international experience (2 credit points minimum), preferably in the fourth year of my course - at least 4 credit points at level 3
