



SLE301 Professional Practice SEBE's Critical Reflection Statement (Template)

Purpose: A reflective task detailing the discipline-specific knowledge and skills that you developed (either during your placement or during your 10+ years of relevant industry experience) evaluated in terms of the relevancy to the Deakin course you are undertaking.

Provide a list of the key activities you performed during your placement.

Document the key experiences in terms of the knowledge gained and skills developed during the placement to develop your capacity to function as a professional.

Provide a summary (100 words max) of how your placement supported your ongoing development of your current employability learning goals.

Provide a summary (200-word max) of how your placement required you to apply and practice discipline-specific knowledge and technical skills.

Reflect on the relevancy of your completed placement to the current professional work context of the Deakin course you are undertaking.

Provide one example of how you can demonstrate that you successfully performed (during your placement), the key professional competencies required to meet the needs of the organisation in which you undertook your placement.

WIL units are designed to also develop insight around your unique career intentions. Provide a summary career plan for how you intend to maintain awareness of discipline-specific job searchers, job application processes and your professional development capabilities for lifelong career planning.
