D380 course rules - In order to qualify for the award of Bachelor of Criminology/Bachelor of Cyber Security (D380), students must complete 32 credit points, which must include the following:

AAI018 Academic Integrity (0-credit-point compulsory unit)

16 credit points of study from the Faculty of Arts and Education – including a minimum of 12 credit points of ACR-coded Criminology units, including:

6 core units: ACR101, ACR102, ACR201, ACR202, ACR301 and ACR302

16 credit points of core SIT-coded units from the Faculty of Science, Engineering and Built Environment
