- Drama
- Media Studies

4 elective units selected from another of the groups of Arts major disciplines listed above (Students taking a major in Anthropology, Australian Studies, Geography, History, Philosophy, Politics or Sociology must select 2 cp of units in one of the others of these among their electives) 4 credit points selected from: EDU201, EDU202, EDU203, EDU303, EDU301, EDU302
