**E377 course rules** - In order to qualify for the award of Bachelor of Health and Physical Education (E377), students must complete 32 credit points, which must include the following:

26 credit points of core units;

Completion of HSE010 Exercise and Sport Laboratory Safety (0 credit point compulsory unit);

4 credit points of discipline study units in a third teaching method area;

2 credit points of curriculum study units in the third teaching method area;

No more than 10 credit points at Level 1; and

Completion of AAI018 Academic Integrity (0-credit-point compulsory unit).

### GENERAL INFORMATION

This course map is a guide only. You must, in addition to using this map, ensure you meet the course rules and structure as set out in the official University Handbook - of the year you commenced your course ([deakin.edu.au/handbook](http://deakin.edu.au/handbook)). This course map has been created to be used electronically.

Not all units are available in all study periods or mode of delivery. Full time study is typically three to four units (or credit points) each study period – this is a typical enrolment pattern. Part time study is typically one to two units (or credit points) each study period – this enrolment pattern of study will extend the duration of your studies. Trimester 3 is typically an optional study period - unless it's your first study period and/or a compulsory study period for your course (see your course structure in the [Handbook](#)).

If you have applied for or received credit for units as recognition of your prior learning (**RPL**), it may alter your course pattern and the units you need to undertake.

### SPECIFIC COURSE INFORMATION

Compulsory zero (0) credit point units/programs/modules: HSE010 Exercise and Sport Laboratory Safety (0 credit point compulsory unit; this safety training must be completed before classes commence) and AAI018 Academic Integrity (0-credit-point compulsory unit).

Students must additionally complete an Emergency First Aid Certificate (Level 2) and AUSTSWIM qualifications prior to graduation.

This course includes 80 days of supervised professional experience.

Students are also required to complete two zero (0) credit point units ELN010 and ELN011 as part of the Literacy and Numeracy Test for Initial Teacher Education (LANTITE) in order to graduate from their course. Students are expected to complete the tests in the first year for undergraduate courses and first trimester for postgraduate courses. This will assist in satisfactory course progression should you need additional support and/or test attempts
