Option 1: Dual Specialist Strand

- 2 credit points of core units;
- 4 research units (EDX701, EDX712, EDX703 and EDX704);
- 4 units of electives from a single specialist strand;
- 2 credit points of electives from another specialist strand;

OR

Option 2: Research Intensive Strand

- 2 credit points of core units;
- 6 research units (EDX701, EDX712, EDX705 (2 credit points) and EDX706 (2 credit points));
- 4 units of electives from a single specialist strand
