Hepatitis B

In the event a student is deemed a non-responder to the Hepatitis B vaccination a letter from a Registered Health Practitioner stating they can attend placement safely is required.

Blood Borne Viruses

Tuberculosis

If a student receives a positive Tuberculosis test or has 'Latent TB' they must supply written documentation from a Registered Health Practitioner advising, they do not have active tuberculosis infection or student is receiving appropriate treatment and is deemed non-infectious and fit for placement.

Influenza

Most health care settings require staff/students to provide evidence of annual influenza vaccine. Follow your school/subjects' requirements.
